PACKED LUNCH VS SCHOOL DINNER

The School Food Trust have carried out a detailed study to find out which is better, packed lunches or school meals. Here are some of their findings:-

Over 90% of pupils taking a school lunch ate food and drink items containing vegetables, salad, pulses or fruit compared with only 58% bringing packed lunches.

Far fewer pupils taking school lunches ate confectionery, nonpermitted drinks and snacks.

The nutrient content of an average packed lunch contained more carbohydrate, added sugar, fat, saturated fat, vitamin C, Sodium Calcium and less protein, fibre and zinc than an school meal.

School lunches are free until your child reaches Year 3, let them try our nutritious school meals - we are having two themed dinners in October.
