Safeguarding

The Health Protection Agency and School Nursing guidelines recommend that your child is kept off school for 48 hours from the last episode of diarrhoea and vomiting. The Health Protection Agency recommends that children do not return to school until all of the spots have dried up and scabbed over. Thank you again for your support.
