#### POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

In order to continue to manage our children's behaviour positively we have removed the weekly Golden Time in favour of a half termly reward system. Children will choose from a list of rewards such as a disco, a movie afternoon or a sports tournament which will take place in the afternoon on the last Friday of each half term. This system will reward the children who are consistently well behaved and hard working. Children who choose not to follow the 'Golden Rules' will not attend.
